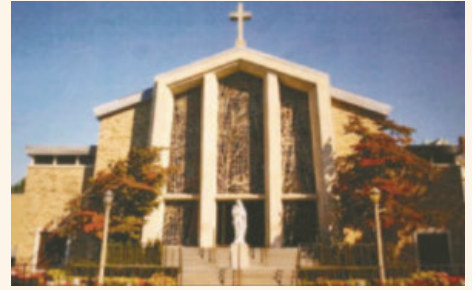

Now that the holidays are over, this is an overdue thank you to every member of the St. Joseph's Parish community that so generously supported our volunteer trip to South Africa in November. I was so moved by all the toiletries that were dropped into the box in the Church Foyer in only a matter of days once the call was put out. With over 325 volunteers this year, the amount of donations, including computers for the schools where we worked, was stunning.

And I am excited to say, over the week our group was there, we built twenty new classrooms, four covered shelters, two kitchens, two toilet blocks and probably most exciting of all for the children, two new playgrounds, at two primary schools in the largest township in Cape Town. 
