



WELCOME NEW PARISHIONERS!

We welcome and invite you to become an active member of the St. Joseph Parish Community. Please introduce yourselves to one of the priests after Mass. If you would like to be registered as a member of our parish, our staff can provide you with the forms needed to do so.

Welcome to the Beginning of the Year of Grace and the Season of Advent!

Advent is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas in which the first Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered. Likewise, it is when our hearts and minds are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent imperatives cause us to live in a state of paranoia; however, it give us readiness as we gain greater sensitivity to the countless ways Christ appears before us each day through the duties of our vocation and life circumstances.

Today, we bless an Advent Wreath! Customarily, the wreath holds three violet-colored candles, and the fourth is a rose. The candles represent the four weeks of Advent, and the number of candles lit each week corresponds to the current week of Advent. The rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete Sunday, which sets a joyful expectation for the Lord's birth and Second Coming.

Throughout the Advent Season, please know the 'LIGHT IS ON' for you on Tuesdays from 6.30 PM to 8.00 PM. And, on Saturdays, from 3.00 PM to 3.45 PM, or by appointment for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As there are no more general absolutions, the available openings for individual reconciliation serve as the Sacramental means for us to draw closer to Our Lord Jesus Christ as we seek His forgiveness and spiritual sustenance. When we examine our conscience and confess our sins, we ask Jesus to come to us in his mercy.

On the third Sunday of Advent, Dec. 17th, members of the Religious Education will play the Christmas pageant at 9.00 AM Mass.

We shall also mark St. John Paull II's beloved tradition of **Bring** Your Baby Jesus to Church Day! It is a beautiful Advent tradition that sanctifies the home with the baby Jesus and makes his arrival in the manger scene even more joyous. We ask that our kids bring their little statue of the baby Jesus that would be placed in their Nativity set at home for blessings. We ask your family to gather around the Crib to sing the sweet carols charged with human and Christian sentiment.

Dear Sisters and Brothers, we belong at the manger just as much as the shepherds, angels, and kings. The Nativity scene is complete once we take our place in it. May the Infant Jesus present in the Crib of your home be the concrete sign of a sincere faith that will enlighten, guide, and direct your life and that of your dear ones
