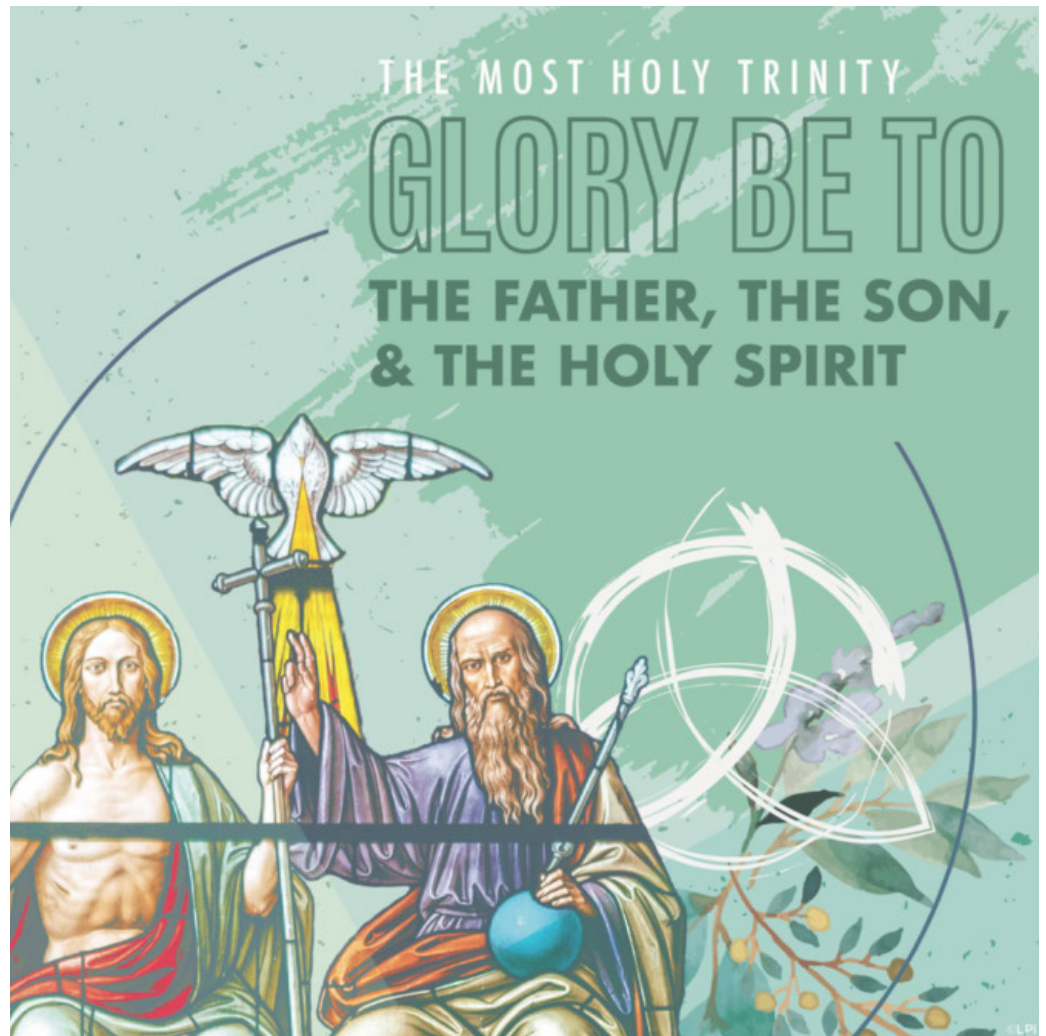

## YEAR OF PARISH EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL JUNE 2023-JUNE 2024

The National Eucharistic Revival is a momentous, three-year initiative that will bear fruit for years. During the previous Year of Diocesan Revival, clergy and diocesan leaders built the foundation for this movement to thrive at the parish level. To enkindle a living relationship with the Lord Jesus in the Holy Eucharist in our parish, we introduced Eucharistic Adoration immediately after the daily 9 am Mass on Mon, Tues, Fri & Sat. Beginning on the Feast of Corpus Christi this year on June 11, 2023, to June 2024, as part of the ongoing Eucharistic Revival campaign, our St. Joseph parish community will embrace four key invitations:

### REINVIGORATED WORSHIP

- Renew the emphasis on the celebration of the liturgy

### PERSONAL ENCOUNTERS

- Host monthly Encounter Nights featuring Eucharistic adoration and the Sacrament of Confession

### ROBUST FORMATION

- Implement the "Jesus and the Eucharist" small group initiative

### SEND MISSIONARIES

- Bring lapsed brothers and sisters home with the "Invite One Back" campaign
- Recommit to serving people experiencing poverty in our community in a new way

To start this unique encounter, we invite you to join in the Eucharistic procession after 10.30 am Mass next weekend on the feast of THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (Corpus Christi). The procession will lead through the Church's front door, and we shall circle the Church compound through the school and back to the Church through the front door. If next weekend's weather permits, this procession can be a sign of common faith and adoration of the real presence in our parish community.

Registration for 2023-2024 will begin on May 8th and will close on June 30th, for all who wish to participate for the upcoming year.

Our program consists of grades 1st through 10th. All participants must register by June 30th. Tuition for one child is \$100, for 2 children \$115 and for 3 or more children \$125. The First Holy Communion fee is \$30 and the Confirmation fee is \$50. There is space available for anyone needing a payment plan. If a family registers a child/children and then moves out of the parish before the beginning of classes, a full refund will be made.

All families who now participate in the program will be able to print a registration form off the parish website starting May 8th.
