FROM THE DESK OF FR. ANTHONY

Eucharistic Revival

Dearest Sisters and Brothers, we shall witness a significant shift in the

arrangement in our Church Sanctuary during the Holy Lent. The Tabernacle position shall be relocated at the head of the sanctuary behind the altar facing the people, while the celebrant and the concelebrant chairs on the side opposite the ambo.

This shift is partly driven to avoid the appearance of a throne for the Priest celebrant and partly inspired by the outcome of the ongoing Eucharistic revival in our parish community to center the Eucharist in our lives and to accord adequate veneration.

"The Eucharist is the center of the Catholic Church because Jesus Christ is the center of Catholic life and worship. The main reason for so great confidence resides in the meaning of the Eucharist: Jesus Christ is here on earth again in the Eucharist, just as he was two thousand years ago. He is not just present in memory. He is not just spiritually present. He is on earth, body and blood, soul and divinity. The doctrine of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist is more than a convenient belief; it is an absolute necessity. The Real Presence is at the heart of every Mass."
